





# Deciduous Shade Trees



# Acer x freemanii (Hybrid Maple) 'Autumn Blaze'

This is an upright, fast-growing, shade tree with ascending branching and a dense, broad-oval crown. Each medium green leaf is deeply cut with five pointed lobes. The foliage turns orange-red to scarlet-red in the fall, hence this maple's cultivar name.

# Acer rubrum (Red Maple) 'Redpointe

Beautiful pyramidal maple with a relatively carefree growth habit. It grows narrower than many other maples, making it an excellent large shade tree for more compact landscapes. Highly adaptable, and resistant to leaf chlorosis. Dark green, heat resistant foliage turns a brilliant red in early autumn.

# Acer negundo (Box Elder/Maple) 'Sensation'

A colorful and unique cultivar of the rugged and adaptable native species, 'Sensation' is a handsome performer for harsh climates. Soft coppery-red foliage welcomes spring, before it matures to a cool medium green color. Sensation's foliage puts on a fall show with striking red, orange, and pink tones.

Broadly oval when young, its branches spread wider than tall, becoming rounded at maturity. Hot Wings Maple has proven to be much more tolerant of high pH soils than other maples.

# Acer rubrum (Red Maple, columnar) 'Armstrong Gold'

A slender column of green that transforms to candle-bright, yellow-orange in the fall. Great selection for screening, park strips/street plantings, and space-challenged gardens.

# Acer truncatum (Shantung Maple) 'Norwegian Sunset'®

# Acer truncatum (Shantung Maple) 'Urban Sunset'®

#### Acer platanoides (Columnar Norway Maple) 'Columnare'



Bur oak or mossycup oak, is one of the most majestic of the native North American oaks. It is a medium to large sized deciduous oak of the white oak group. It has a broad-spreading, rounded crown. Acorn cups are covered with a mossy scale or bur near the rim, hence the common names. The acorns are an important source of food for wildlife.



#### **Quercus bicolor (Swamp White Oak)**



Chosen by the City of Denver's "Mile High Million" tree planting, this Elm is resistant to Dutch Elm Disease. It has reddish-purple fall color. Very tough and tolerant of a wide variety of conditions. This tree is a cross between Lacebark Elm and Smooth Leaf Elm.

It is highly tolerant of urban pollution.

Easily grown in average, medium, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Prefers moist, fertile, well-drained loams, but adapts to a wide range of soil conditions. Good tolerance for urban conditions. Fragrant, creamy yellow flowers in drooping cymes appear in June. When a tree is in full bloom, bees often visit in such abundant numbers that humming can be heard many feet from the tree.



# Tilla tomentosa (Silver Leaf Liden) 'Sterling'

Water/Soil: Average, very adaptive.

It is noted for its attractive foliage, which is glossy green above and silvery-white below. The foliage flutters in the slightest breeze, showcasing the silver and green leaf colors. Easily grown in average, dry to medium, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Prefers moist, fertile, well-drained loams, but adapts to a wide range of soil conditions. Best drought resistance of any of the lindens. Good tolerance for urban conditions





#### Platanus x acerifolia (London Plane Tree) 'Bloodgood'

Fall Color: Bronzy yellowish-gold

Water/Soil: Average-moist, well drained.

Fast-growing, this handsome, vigorousgrowing variety exhibits a very uniform branching habit and features large, maplelike bright-green leaves. Adding further appeal is its smooth peeling bark in shades of green, gray and tan. Revered for its ability to withstand urban conditions. Well-suited as a street, park or lawn tree, and thrives in a full sun exposure with regular watering in a well-drained soil.





Celtis occidentalis (Hackberry)

Mature gray bark develops corky ridges and wart-like texture. Insignificant greenish flowers appear in spring, with male flowers in clusters and female flowers solitary. Female flowers give way to round fleshy berry-like fruit maturing to deep purple. Fruits are very attractive to birds. Fleshy parts of the fruit are edible and somewhat sweet.

Tulip tree or yellow poplar, is a large, stately tree with a pyramidal to broad conical habit. Trunks of mature trees may reach 4-6' in diameter, usually rising column-like with an absence of lower branching. It is named and noted for its cup-shaped, tulip-like flowers that bloom in spring.





#### Morus alba (Fruitless Mulberry) 'Kingan'

#### Gymnocladus dioicus (Kentucky Coffeetree) 'True North'





This graceful giant is known for its open crown of wispy, ground-sweeping branches and long, slender leaves. Often seen as one of the first indications of spring, the weeping willow's yellow twigs and green foliage appear early in the season. The tree is easy to grow and quick to take root. It lends itself well to planting singly or in small groves near the edge of ponds, lakes and rivers.

#### Zelkova serrata (Sawleaf Zelkova) 'Village Green'

This cultivar is distinguished from the species by its rapid growth, straight and smooth trunk, and an upright vase shape with dark green foliage.

# Zelkova serrata (Sawleaf Zelkova) 'Green Vase'



The Japanese zelkova is a good street and shade tree that has an appealing vase-shaped form with a rounded crown. The peeling bark on older trees exposes orange patches, which can be quite impressive. It is tolerant to drought and air pollution, making it a nice option for a variety of urban locations.



#### Betula nigra (Heritage River Birch) 'Cully'

A Beautiful, multi-branched tree provides striking winter interest, with bare branches and trunk displaying highly textured and colorful, peeling bark. Exceptional subject for night lighting. This versatile, highly heat tolerant tree thrives in sites with high water tables yet adapts to mild drought when established.



Heritage (river) birch are completely resistant to bronze birch borer, as it does not produce the attracting hormone: rhododendrin

#### Betula utilis var. jacquemontii (Himalayan Birch)

An exceptional tree with a graceful, open-branched, pyramidal form, exquisite peeling bark, and terrific fall color. Toothy, tapered, dark green foliage transforms to a bright yellow in the fall. Showy catkins drape from the tree in spring.



#### Zelkova serrata (Columnar Zelkova) 'Musashino'

Tightly columnar in form, it is ideal for planting along narrow city streets ad other confined areas. This tall and slender tree provides welcome shade while rising above traffic to accommodate passing vehicles and pedestrians.



## Celtis (Columnar Hackberry) 'Prairie Sentinel'

Tolerates moderate drought.

This fastigiate hackberry fills the need for a columnar tree for narrow city streets in the toughest climates. Discovered in the rugged high plains of western Kansas, it has great adaptability to heat, drought, and cold of the prairie and harsh urban sites.



#### Betula platyphylla (Columnar Birch) 'Parkland Pillar'

Parkland Pillar® is a beautiful birch with a narrow, upright, dense habit. It boasts white bark and dense, dark green foliage that turns golden in late fall. This fast-growing variety is suitable for small yards. Tolerant of heat, drought, and alkaline soils, Parkland Pillar is an excellent choice for urban landscapes. Its narrow form makes it perfect as an accent tree or it can be planted in multiples to form a privacy screen.

#### Betula platyphylla (Columnar Birch) 'Dakota Pinnacle'

It is very adaptable to both dry and moist locations. It is not particular as to soil type or PH. It is highly tolerant of urban pollution and will thrive in inner city environments. Dakota Pinnacle® is deer resistant. It makes a great vertical accent or specimen tree.



#### Fagus sylvatica (Columnar Beech) 'Dawyck Purple'

Does not do well with heavy, clay soils.

The dark purple foliage of this magnificent columnar tree is difficult not to notice. Deep reddish-purple leaves emerge and darken to burgundy purple. It is one of the most striking and beautiful of all columnar trees.



#### Fagus sylvatica (Purple Beech) 'Riversii'

The deepest purple foliage of any purple-leafed beech with richly colored foliage that retains its dark purple color throughout the summer months. A special selection from England. A magnificent specimen tree for larger landscapes. Not recommended for hot, dry areas.



# Liriodendron tulipifera (Tulip Tree) 'Emerald City'®

A refined cultivar of our familiar native tulip tree, this uniform growing selection is straighter and more upright, with a dominant central leader and deeper green, slightly glossy foliage.



# Cladrastis kentukea (Yellowwood)

#### Sorbus aucuparia (Cardinal Royal® Mountain Ash) 'Michred'

#### Maackia amurensis (Maackia)



Amur maackia is a small, deciduous tree with a broad, rounded habit. It features erect, narrow, spike-like clusters (4-6" long) of fragrant, white, pea-like flowers which appear in late spring. Coppery-bronze bark exfoliates on mature trees.



#### Malus sargentii (Flowering Crabapple) 'Tina'

Tina crabapple is a very small, rounded, dwarf tree. In spring, bright red flower buds open to single white flowers. It bares small ¼", bright red fruit in the fall.

# Malus (Crabapple) 'Royal Raindrops'

Bright pinkish red flowers combine with purple cutleaf foliage. Orange-red fall color. Fruit is small, few, and persistent, which means that they do not drop.

#### Malus (Flowering Crabapple) 'Royal Gem'
